The Alumni Association of the University of Manitoba has established an endowment fund to offer scholarships to students who have demonstrated extracurricular involvement at the university. - (4) submits an essay (maximum 300 words) that speaks to their involvement with University of Manitoba organizations and/or activities and the personal significance of their experiences.

Essay Questions

Applicants are required to submit a 300 word essay on the following question:
