### Presentation Formats

- [PechaKucha](#) – 7 presenters selected

PechaKucha 20x20 is a simple presentation format where you show 20 images, each for 20 seconds. The images advance automatically and the presenter will talk along to the images. For this event, presenters are asked to come up with an idea, project or general talk related to one of the five topic areas of the event. After the presentations are complete, students, faculty and staff will be encouraged to ask the presenters questions during the informal meet and greet session at the end of the evening.

- **Panelist** – 5 panelists selected

Panelists will be selected to give a 5-minute presentation each about the five key topic areas of the event. Members of the audience will be encouraged to ask questions of the panelists to engage in a group panel conversation.
