We are excited to present the Bruce D. Campbell Farm and Food Discovery Centre summer day camp, a new interactive camp that will be held from Monday, July 21, to Friday, July 26, 2014. Every day will be filled with many fun and exciting activities focusing on agriculture and food in Manitoba. This camp is open to children between the ages of 7 to 13. There are only 15 spots available so register soon! The final date for registration is July 5, 2014.

The cost for the camp is **\$135.00** dollars per camper, and is payable by cheque made out the University of Manitoba, MasterCard, Visa, or cash. Registration can be paid when the registration form is mailed or faxed (credit card only) back to us. If for whatever reason your child can not attend camp please contact us by July 17th at the latest. There will be a \$15.00 administration charge for processing the refund. Activity Schedule

This schedule is subject to change due to the weather, and other circumstances outside of our control.

Monday July 21: Little Green Thumb

This day is all about growth and care for your own garden at home as well as non-grain crops grown in Manitoba. The campers will plant beans, tomatoes, sunflowers and different herbs, which they can take home with them at the end of the week. During this day we will also be learning about plants' effect on greenhouse gases, and how we can help. The campers will also be working out in the garden if weather permits. On top of all this learning, the campers will be making potato pancakes for a snack in the afternoon and tomato sauce for the pizza day on the Friday.

Tuesday July 22: Extraordinary Eggs

Investigate the science behind chickens and eggs in a full-day workshop where campers learn about caring for chickens; study egg formation inside the hen; determine the age of the egg; perform CSI-style investigations to match the egg to the hen; and separate and cook with eggs in the centre's kitchens to create tasty treats.

Wednesday July 23: Dairy Day

With a working dairy barn on site, this program begins with a dairy tour to build an understanding of how milk is produced and what is involved in agricultural biosecurity. Campers will have the opportunity to learn about various dairy products and how each are created, making butter and ice cream from raw materials. After all of that, the campers will help make cheese for the pizza that will be made on Friday.

Thursday July 24: World of Wheat

Learn about this staple crop by following the stages of wheat from planting to harvest. Understand the unique attributes of wheat that allow us to use it in so many different ways. Campers will engage in hands-on learning through harvesting and cleaning wheat, milling wheat to create flour, chewing wheat to stimulate gluten formation and baking bread. Working in small groups, campers choose how much white and whole wheat flour to use for their loaves, and we compare the final results using all of our senses while learning about the health benefits of whole grains. We will also touch on many other grain crops in Manitoba, as well as prep the dough for the pizza crusts for Friday.

Friday July 25: Pizza Wind Up

The final day of camp will be a day where the campers can showcase all that they have learned over the week by making pizzas in small groups for themselves and their parents. There will also be a small award ceremony after lunch.

Please ensure that your child/children are prepared for the weather, such as providing appropriate clothing or sunscreen/bug spray. Please also ensure that the campers are getting a hearty breakfast before arrival as some days there will be no snack break. There is water and a fridge available on the premises for lunches. The water is not chlorinated city water; however it is pumped in from Sanford. For all belongings, please make sure that they are all labeled with the camper's name in case it is lost.

Being Absent From Camp

If your child must be away from camp for unexpected reasons (ex. illness), please call 204-883-2524 to notify us. If your child will be absent for planned reasons (ex. vacation, appointments, etc), please notify your group leader in advance by a written note.

Camp Dismissal

Children will only be released to individuals authorized for pick up submitted at the time of registration. Individuals on this list are welcome to authorize other adults to pick up their child by submitting a signed note to your group leader. All adults picking up their child require photo identification and may be asked to provide signature.

Pick Up begins at 3:30pm and supervision is available until 4:30 pm. Do your best to pick up your child before 4:00pm to hear all about the day from your child's group leader.

For the safety of all children, please be patient with us and be sure you have signed out with one of our staff during this busy time before leaving with your child. Present our staff with your photo ID and our staff will ask for your initials to sign your child out.

Refund Policy

If a camper cannot attend and must be withdrawn from the camp, there will be a \$15 administration fee for processing the refund. The remaining \$120.00 will be refunded.

Withdrawal must be done before July 17th at the latest. If the child is withdrawn from the camp after the 17th, there will be no refund issued.
