

COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

The Alumni Association of the University of Manitoba has established an endowment fund to offer scholarships to students who have demonstrated extracurricular involvement at the university. Each year, the available income from the fund will be used to offer one or more scholarships, with a minimum value of \$1,000 each, to undergraduate students who:

- (1) are enrolled full-time or part-time in any faculty, college, or school at the University of Manitoba;
- (2) have achieved a minimum degree grade point average of 3.0;
- (3) have demonstrated extra-curricular involvement at the university.
- (4) Submits an essay (maximum 300 words) that speaks to their involvement with the University of Manitoba organizations and/or activities and the personal significance of their experiences.

(See below for essay question. Applicants selected for this award may have their essay, or a portion of the essay, published in promotional materials for the University of Manitoba.)

When submitting your application, please include:

- Completed application form
- Copy of your current transcript (a printout of your online copy is acceptable)
- Essay (300 words max.)
- List of volunteer activities & number of hours per month.
