Role of women in the context of Sufi history has been critically understudied from the 17th-20th CE.




How do women represent themselves in these public gendered spaces? What did their lives look like?

Theoretical framework: Interdisciplinary Body history, Religious studies and Anthropology








What cultural, political and relious influence does the women's body represent?
















## Why use postcards?


Postcard images demonstrate important architectures and perceptions of the localities.
